To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

On the 31st, day of January, 1889, Winfield S. Shields was appointed
Postmaster at Brady, in the County of Indiana, State of Pennsylvania,
and, on the 5th day of February, 1889, execute a Bond, and has taken the Oath of Office
according to law:

And we, That confiding in the integrity, ability, and punctuality of the said Winfield S. Shields,
do hereby appoint him a Postmaster, authorized to execute the duties of that Office at Brady,
according to the Laws of the United States and the Regulations of the Post Office Department:
