Luke Peterson, the University of Pittsburgh's Visiting Professor in Contemporary International Issues, will give a lecture titled "Contending Discourses: Palestine-Israel in the Print News Media" at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 26, in the HUB Susquehanna room.

Peterson works on contemporary representations of Palestine-Israel in print media in Great Britain and the United States. His research compares portrayals of the two regions and connects divergent public and social interpretations of conflict in the Middle East to disparate representations in print language media. He teaches courses on "The U.S. in the Middle East" and the "History of the Palestinian-Israeli conflict."
