Eric Rubenstein, [Department of Philosophy](#), was recently interviewed as part of a three-part series on the nature of time, hosted by the website [Cosmoetica](#).

Rubenstein spoke to contemporary philosophical debates on the nature of time, alongside interviews with a physicist and a theologian. Cosmoetica features interviews conducted by its founder, Dan Schneider, with experts in the arts and sciences. Notable interviews have included ones with Bishop John Shelby Spong, novelist Charles Johnson, philosopher Daniel Dennett, journalist Pete Hamill, psychologist Steven Pinker, Desmond Morris, author of *The Naked Ape*, and Pulitzer Prize winning journalist Charlie LeDuff, as well as panel discussions on major works of art and artists.
