Dear Judge

I have just now
been handed your note of
the 8th (most needed 9th) at
Baltimore, asking me to
send on Kinter's deposition.

It is too late to send to Indiana
and so I mail it today directly
to the Prothy at Brookville,
and I write you there.

You mention that you
sent me a check for Kinter's
note - I have not yet rec^d
it but as you sent it, it
will doubtless still come
to hand, although the check
you sent me to Washington
for Haney's \$300. never reached
me - I rec^d when I got by
all my letters, but it was not

among them - But as Winter
has arranged with you to pay
the money, it is all right
whether this check comes
to hand or not.

I will attend to the
Price, when I can,
but the accumulation of
business on my table, in my
