Executive Chamber,

Harrisburg Pa. 9 July 1864

My dear Judge

I have information that
near about the 30th May Major
White and four other officers
escaped from a prison between
Salsburg South Carolina and
Macon Georgia - Two of them are
now within our lines - Henry
has not yet arrived -

When he is heard
from I will immediately com-
municate with you - This informa-
tion should not be made public
or any part of it - I sincerely hope
he may get safely within our lines
soon
