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## Letter from Mary Durang to Thomas White, January 6, 1865

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Lister Ellen 165-My dear brother I was truly rejoiced whear that yours and Kates health had improved, the mind is calmost every thing and as yours was in such a state of anxiety you suffered I do hope Rich and thany will leave the army, From what I have heard Richard is not suited for it in one way and that way concerns his interests. he acts from his own sense of justice and right the Army require strict discipline and only that . -Il governs courage, justice and feeling. - hence has has been worried and those who cared for han by acting according to the empulses of a good heart and a good judg ment; it is a gratification to him to know that, that is appreciated by those who he had under him, and those who felt inter est in his wefare. Truly red tape does much injustice I should have liked to have seen dearry, not that I suppose all I could say would have any effect. But if he had seen you, as I saw you I think he would not he sitate as to the course to perfece who night the you had the interview with the person who was on here from the south. I could not sleep you were before me did not write to Indiane fearing to fighten late. In I wrote to Many to Ballimore to see if they had heard from you - If theory had seen you then! And what lale

has suffered I am sure none can tell but those Who have gone through such trials . - I did not know fane wrote you .. I have been very ile indeed when D'Levis was called in there was scarcely any pulse left I was so debilitade. The organs of digestion had almost ceased to work - he ordered atimudationed things - I am much better but very weak yet when the weather clears so that I can get out I hope to get more strength - I am sorry to hear Richards wifes health is bad - I suppose the distressing bereavenes that has be fallen her has effected her. I feel for her. . I suppose you have heard of Nors Strithers death. Dear little Nettee Savage broke hea arm the week before last it is mending fast-fane was in severte times lately. - I have no news Give Our loves to whate yourself and all the farmely and believe me your ever affectionale Tester Mary
