SIR:

Your claim for pension has been received, recorded, and given a number as below, and will be taken up for action in its regular turn. The intervening time can be employed in preparing necessary evidence, which, in case the claim is that of a widow, should consist of proof of death of the soldier; proof of marriage with date thereof, and that she is without means of support other than her daily labor. If the claim be that of dependent relative, proof of death of soldier; that he (soldier) left no widow or minor child, and that the claimant was dependent upon him for support, will be required.

Evidence in Invalid claims under this act will be called for, if needed, after a medical examination, and when the claim is taken up for action.
