TO ANY Post of the GRAND ARMY OF THE REPUBLIC, Greeting:

This Certifies that Comrade *Winfield S. Shields* is a member in good standing of this Post, and having paid all dues, we have granted him this

HONORABLE DISCHARGE.

THE FOLLOWING IS A CORRECT TRANSCRIPT FROM THE RECORDS OF THE POST:

Comrade *Winfield S. Shields* is *34* years of age, was born in *Indiana Co.* State of *Penna.* and is by occupation a *Physician* entered the service on the *22* day of *July* 1864 as a *Private* Co. *G* 1st Regt. *Pa. Art. Vols.* and was finally discharged on the *29* day of *June* 1865 as *Private* Co. *G* 1st Regt. *Pa. Vol. Art. Vols.* by reason of *close of War* having served *one* years *4* months.

Dated at *Marion Center, Pa.* this *31* day of *December* 1887.
